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H. NARRATIVE (attach additional pages as necessary)

1. Accomplishments:

We seccessfully adopted the philosophy of House Bill 29 well before the law went into effect. We gained a high level of compliance with minimal enforcement through education.

In cooperation with Lorain Coast Guard, we standardized the wake zones in Lorain Harbor. We strengthened relationships with Lorain Coast Guard, Lorain Police Dept. & Dive Team, and Lorain Fire Dept. through joint training and working local event together. We assisted other agencies as requested.

2. Problems:

Our vessel is ten years old. It is currently in sound condition but maintenance issues tend to grow exponentially with age. This year we had to replace an engine supercharger. Next year our boat engines will meet their life expectancy. If an engine fails, the total cost to replace it could consume the major portion of our funding.
