Rick and Ralph,

Thank you for your sponsorship of the FireFish Festival, for your support of this event, and for reserving the Black River Landing for our potential use for FireFish. As I described in a walk-through with Ralph late last week, the early part of the festival will be concentrating on utilizing storefronts and locations on Broadway Avenue. We would still like to use the Black River Landing site, specifically for the final culminating performance of FireFish in the parking lot directly across 7th Street and Black River Lane.

The performance will follow a "parade" that will begin at the Main Stage and various other sites along Broadway, featuring drumming, dancers, and a 20' paper mache FireFish puppet constructed by artist Daniel McNamara with the assistance of Lorain youth participating in FireFish502. The parade will process east down 7th Street through the roadway between the Eagles Building and Palace Theatre, head north to the south gate of the Black River Landing, and then proceed south to the "stage" area in the parking lot as shown in the diagram below.

At the point indicated on the map, viewers will split from the performers. Performers will process through the gate and will lineup on the north side of the fence where they will remain until the audience is in place. Audience members will be guided by volunteers to the viewing area as noted on the map.

The Main Event Performance will take place within a circular area having a diameter of 50' and marked off with roping. The performance will feature a full range of performers, including a cello solo, ballet, drumming, belly dancing, the True North Men's Choir and a Children's Choir, as well as Fire and Light Performing artists and featured Fire Artist Cavan Meese. Following a performance by Meese and ballet dancer Brittany Drost, the papier mache FireFish will be lit and burnt. It will sit atop a platform of approximately 20 pallets, creating a small but short bonfire.

All fire performers are certified and insured. The FireFish Festival event insurance covers this performance and would add the Lorain Port Authority as an additional insured. Executive Director James Levin has met and continues to meet with representatives from the Fire Department to meet all codes necessary. We have been advised by the certified fire performers that the short fire will not damage the asphalt. The area will be power-washed after the event as necessary to remove any ash or debris.

In addition to permission to use the parking lot for the final performance, it is requested that all of the lights are working and on to provide illumination for safety, that the dumpsters are moved (Ralph identified the location that is their usual site) and that access is to five 20 amp circuits are provided for some additional lighting and sound support.

We would appreciate your expedited confirmation of the use of the space as described above. The FireFish Festival will provide all necessary documents as described above and James Levin has a meetings with the Fire Marshall mid-week. We are anxious to get all approvals in place and to make sure we are in compliance with all safety and other regulations.
