2020 Highlights

Ariel on Broadway Hotel, Event Center and Rooftop Opens

Ariel on Broadway Hotel, Event Center and Rooftop opened for business in March 2020. A ribbon cutting ceremony was held on March 2, 2020, and despite the difficulties caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, the hotel was able to host events including a rooftop dinner for the Independence Day Fireworks Display and a Broadway Rooftop Sunset Series. **Dodie's**

Victory Park

Victory Park at the corner of West Erie Avenue and West Fifth Street in Lorain saw a number of improvements in 2020. Work started in March with the removal of trees and the old flag pole. The site then received lawn treatments, three new flag poles and new landscaping around the monument.

The bent utility pole was removed and replaced with underground electricity, and up lighting was added for the trees and flag poles.



Caren S. Franzini Fellowship, New Title & a Promotion

In March 2020, the **Council of Development Finance Authorities** (CDFA) announced our Assistant Director Tiffany McClelland was one of four women selected for the 2020 Class of the **Caren S. Oasis Marinas First Season in Lorain

Oasis Marinas at Port Lorain, 301 Lakeside Ave. #1, opened for its first season under new management on April 17, 2020.



Throughout the year the marina saw improvements such as a new boater's lounge, new gangways on all of the docks and a freshly resealed parking lot. Improvements were also made to the landscaping outside the new marina office located inside the same building as Erie Steak and Seafood Co. Additional improvements are planned for 2021, and **Erie Shore Rentals & Detailing**, 301 Lakeside Ave., recently moved into the former marina office that is in the same parking lot as the

restaurant.

Cabela's Master Walleye Circuit Tournament

The **Cabela's Masters Walleye Circuit Tournament** returned to Black River Landing on June 5 & 6, 2020. Due to COVID-19, the set-up was altered slightly and walleye weigh-ins were done drive-thru style. Participants from 12 different states competed in the tournament and a total of 832 fish were caught weighing in at 4,072lbs! The fish caught during the two-day event were donated to Second Harvest Food Bank to help families in need. More than \$62,000 in cash and prizes were awarded to the anglers who participated.



The Summer Market

New to Black River Landing in 2020 was **The Summer Market**. The Port Authority partnered with the nonprofit **Girls Give Back** to bring this event to Lorain after 14 years in Avon Lake. On July 18 & 19, 2020, the one-of-a-kind shopping experience and fundraising event filled the festival grounds with a curated grouping of artists, makers, pickers, collectors, growers and foodies. Black River Bikeway Mile Marker 0.0

In November 2020, the **Lorain County Metro Parks** held ribbon cutting ceremonies and officially opened of two new links to the Black River Bikeway along the North Coast Inland Trail. We were grateful for the opportunity to partner with the Metro Parks to create Mile Marker 0.0 at Lakeside Landing near the entrance to Oasis Marianas at Port Lorain, 301 Lakeside Avenue. The North Coast Inland Trail now stretches more than 103 miles from Lorain to the Maumee River in Lucas County.



International Tree & Model Train Display

The **International Tree and Model Train Display** filled the Train Station, 421 Black River Lane, at Black River Landing for the ninth year in November/December 2020. Instead of the typical indoor walk-through display, the 2020 rendition was a window display due to COVID-19 guidelines. Visitors could gaze at the beautifully decorated trees and intricate train displays while walking around the perimeter of the building. Lorain's Caboose C-3855 was also decorated with lights, and an outdoor display of Santa's sleigh
